Fairmont is used in commercial laundries (in the wash wheel) to remove rust stains, brighten linen that has dulled due to excess minerals in the water and reclaim linen that has been damaged from concrete stains. It is also used as a sour in extreme rust conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Fairmont is for industrial use only. It should be used in a wash formula specifically designed to meet the needs of your facility.

DANGER

HAZARD STATEMENTS

Causes severe skin burns and eye damage. Harmful if swallowed.



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Wear protective gloves, splash goggles, face shield, full suit, respirator and boots. Do not breathe dust/mist. Wash thoroughly

FIRST AID

Eye Contact. Check for and remove any contact lenses. Flush with large quantities of water, holding eyelids open for 15 minutes. Seek medical attention immediately. **Skin Contact.** Wash skin with copious amount of water. Seek medical attention immediately. **Inhalation.** Remove to fresh air. Flush mouth and nasal passage with water repeatedly. Seek medical attention immediately. **Ingestion.** Do not induce vomiting. Drink copious amounts of water. Seek medical attention immediately.

STORAGE

Store in original container protected from sunlight, in a well ventilated area, away from incompatible materials, and food and drink. Keep out of reach of children.

SPILL/LEAK

Avoid runoff into storm sewers and ditches which leads to waterways. Vacuum or sweep up material and place in a designated, labeled container.

DISPOSAL

Dispose of material in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.
